Public Input - Discussion regarding minor child riding 4 wheeler on city street, per state law must be licensed, insured, and driven by licensed driver. (from cpsc.gov; Iowa Law; **State Laws:** All ATVs must be registered and titled if used on public lands, except for those used solely for agricultural purposes. All registered ATVs are to receive one numbered sticker; renewal is once every year. No one under 12 can operate an ATV unless on private land. No one under 18 can operate an ATV on public lands unless they possess a safety training certificate. No passengers are allowed on the ATV unless it is designed to carry more than one person. ATV use on highways is prohibited, except to cross these roads and for agricultural purposes and then only during daylight hours. ATVs operated during hours of darkness shall have lighted head lamp and tail lamp)

Discussion regarding profanity on a vehicle in town, council member will ask owner to remove.

Rowan Fun Day Update - Ketchum reported that the day went well, seemed to have better attendance than previous years, and already showing more revenue than last year, however financials are not yet complete, more participation in kids activities, event continues to grow.

Maintenance Report - Virgil Park - work performed and work that needs to be completed.

Sewer Progress - Discussion regarding efforts to acquire additional funding through the USDA, will not be able to award contract until funding is secured. Motion made by Ketchum to set a Special Meeting date on June 19th at 7:00 PM for the purpose of awarding the contract pending additional funding.
