Things to keep in mind:

- Regularly inspect your system. Do not use septic tank additives.
- Use water efficiently.
- Don't dispose of household hazardous wastes in sinks and toilets.
- Plant only grass over and near your septic system. Roots from nearby trees or shrubs might clog and damage the drainfield.

Don't drive or park vehicles on any part of your septic system.

Doing so can compact the soil in your drainfield or damage the pipes, tank, or other septic system components.

Protect It, Inspect It, Respect It - Annually check over your system.

√Think at the Sink: Avoid pouring fats, grease and solids down the drain.

√Don't Overload the Commode: Only put items in the drain/toilet that belong there.

√Don't Strain Your Drain: Be water efficient and spread out water use.

√Shield Your Field: Remind family and guests not to park or drive on a system's drainfield, where the weight could cause damage.

√Spy with Your Eyes: Regularly check the tank lids, cleanout risers, and D-Box lid.
