

Rowan City Council Meeting June 3, 2019

Mayor Ronnie Bailey opened the meeting at 7:00 PM.

Council persons present- Mark Bruns, Dale Hollman, and Virgil Park.

Minutes of the May 6, 2019 meeting were approved with a motion by Hollman, second by Park. Carried.

Motion to approve Treasurer's report by Bruns, second by Park. Carried

Maintenance Report - New signs have been mounted at water dept, other items still in progress.

Propane Contract - Motion to approve proposed contract with W&H Coop by Bruns, 2nd by Park. Approved.

Spare Parts for Sewer System - parts and prices discussed, decisions on how many to purchase of each. Motion by Hollman to put in the order for spare parts, 2nd by Bruns. Approved. Council also discussed having a public meeting with residents before wrapping up project.

Sewer accounts Audit required by USDA - Motion by Bruns to hire Hogan and Hansen to perform the audit, 2nd by Park. Approved.

Heaters at Water Department - Bruns will get with Water employees after the 14th to take them down and store them. Need to purchase some ladders.

Gravel for streets/alleys - Discussion on equipment needed to put the gravel in the alley's without making a mess in backyards of residences. Will research for next meeting.

Sewer Progress - Final clean up is in process, leveling, grading, seeding, etc. Forrest Aldrich still working with DNR to get new Iron Filtration system installed at waterworks.

Motion by Park to adjourn, 2nd by Hollman. Carried.
